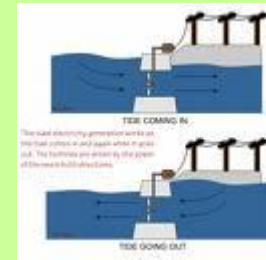


Welcome to St Peter's Geography Week

Key Stage 1 are learning what it is like to live in Spain.

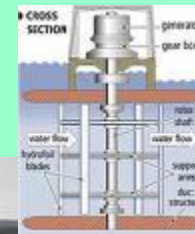
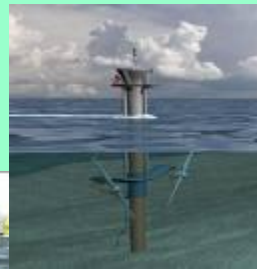
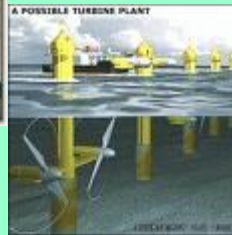


Key Stage 2 are learning about TIDAL POWER!
