**WARM WISH BRICK SCHEME**

The Warm Wish Group raises funds towards the improvement of the facilities of St Peters School swimming pool. Our school is very fortunate to have this valuable resource in which many of the children learn to swim and improve their swimming skills before they leave. However, this resource brings with it many expenses and it is for this reason that the Warm Wish Group like to contribute funds to make the pool environment attractive and appealing for the children to use.

In the past we have given families the opportunity to buy an engraved brick and become part of the school’s history. You may well have seen the many bricks we have sold mounted on either side of the entrance to the pool area.

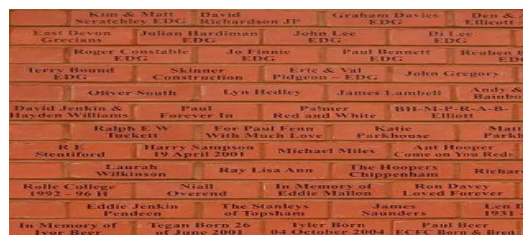
We would like to offer families once again the opportunity to buy a brick which will be mounted alongside the existing ones. Each brick will have room for up to 25 characters and will be engraved in a clear black font. You can have several names on one brick, up to this total, or buy more than one brick and have them mounted next to each other, on special request. **(Please make sure that this is indicated on the application form).**

The cost of each engraved and mounted brick will be £25 and is open to all pupils, parents, grandparents and other family members.

Not only will your names be on display for all to see for many years to come, but you will have contributed towards the Warm Wish funds to raise money for the improvement of the swimming pool facilities. We are hoping for some improvements to take place at the end of this year’s swimming season, ready for the start of the new season early next year.
