### Club Descriptions

Before each club we will ensure there is a chance for your child to have a snack and a drink that they bring in from home.

### Cost of Clubs led by St Peter's C of E Primary School

Clubs organised by St Peter's Church of England Primary School cost **£4 per club** (no charge for lunchtime clubs). Please make payment to the office as soon as possible, (cheques made payable to Devon County Council). The revenue from our after school clubs will be used to support lunchtime resources.

### Cost of Clubs led by External Providers.

Please note that Exeter City Football in the Community, Gymnastics (Mrs Kilburn), KS1 Recorder Club and Tennis (Coach Oli) have their own charges. These individuals/organisations are responsible for the content and behaviour management at these clubs.

### Pupil Premium

The pupil premium is additional funding to raise the attainment of eligible pupils of all abilities.
